

ORDINANCE No: 2017-01
AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE, REPEAL, AND RECREATE
CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 2 OF THE VILLAGE OF ARLINGTON
CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING POLICE OFFICERS

WHEREAS, The Village Board of the Village of Arlington, Columbia County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

1. Section 2.32 is repealed and recreated so that:

There shall be no regular police officers elected, appointed or employed by the Village. All police services shall be provided by ~~County law enforcement authorities~~ the Village of Poynette Police Department pursuant to contract with the Village. The Village Board may at any time change the method of providing law enforcement by repealing this Section.

Severability of Provisions. Should any section, sentence, phrase or other portion of this Ordinance be declared invalid, such portion shall be deemed as a separate and distinct provision and shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Effective date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced upon its passage and publication or posting as provided by law. Except as provided herein, all of the terms and provisions of Chapter 2 of the Village of Arlington Code of Ordinances shall remain in full force and effect.


